The **Asheville High School Memorial Scholarship** is a one-time award of \$1000 to a student who exhibits good character, leadership skills, has maintained a 3.0 GPA, and has financial need. Requires FAFSA.

The **Dr. Keith Black Scholarship** is a one-time award of \$400 to a student pursuing a health-related career who has participated in at least one extra-curricular activity or works after school and has at least a 3.0 GPA.

The **Commander Guy R. Bostain ROTC Scholarship** is a \$1,000 award to a ROTC student with a history of leadership activities.

The **Mitchell Carlisle Memorial Scholarship** is a \$1000 award to a student ranked in the Top 20% of the class who has been involved in athletics and participates in school activities.

The **Deutsch Family Scholarship** is a one-time award of \$1000 to a student with financial need who has promoted racial, religious and cultural harmony while in school. (Additional Essay Required) Requires FAFSA

William E. Drake Scholarship is a one-time award of \$2,500 to a student who will attend UNC Chapel Hill, is in the top 20% of the class and has worked to help support him/herself while in high school.

The **Lee H. Edwards Class of '48 Scholarship** is a one-time award of \$1,500 to a student in the upper 30% of the class with significant financial need who will attend a NC publicly funded four-year or community college. Requires FAFSA.

The **Lee H. Edwards Class of '51 Career & Technical Education Scholarships** are two one-time awards of \$1000 to graduates in the pursuit of career and technical education. The primary emphasis will be for students attending Asheville Buncombe Technical Community College, but awards can also be made for other technical schools in light of a worthy request.

The **Mel Hetland Scholarship** is a one-time award of \$500-\$1000 to a minority student who will attend a NC publicly funded college, who has financial need, participates in community service and has a weighted GPA of 3.0 or better. Preference will be given to a student who is first in the family to attend college. Requires FAFSA.

The **GE Aviation Scholarship** is a one-time award of \$500 to a student pursuing machining or engineering at either a 2 or 4 year college. Preference is given to a female or minority student. Requires FAFSA.

The **Josten's Scholarship** is a one-time award of \$500 to a student involved in extra-curricular activities who also has at least a 3.0 GPA.

The Bruce & Jean Larson Community Service Scholarship is a \$2400 award to one student payable at \$600 each year for 4 years (subject to satisfactory performance and progress). It is awarded to a student who will attend a four-year college or university, has a 3.0 GPA or better, has financial need, has a concern for others as demonstrated by significant community service activities throughout high school, and has an interest in and respect for cultural diversity as demonstrated by relevant school and community activities. Requires FAFSA.

The **John B. Lewis Scholarship** is a one-time award of \$1,000 to a student who will attend a NC publicly funded four-year or community college. The student must have a GPA of 3.0 or better; have participated in team sports at Asheville High School; and show evidence of leadership ability, community service and /or employment experience. Financial need is not a factor.

The **McElroy Engineering Scholarship** is a one-time award of \$1300 to a student who will attend NC State or UNCA to study engineering. Need is a factor. Requires FAFSA.

The **People Helping People Scholarship** from the State Employees Credit Union Foundation is a four-year scholarship of \$10,000, (subject to satisfactory performance and progress,) payable at \$1,250 per semester for attendance at one of the 16 constituent campuses of the University of North Carolina. Student must have a 2.5 GPA or better on a 4.0 scale, and must demonstrate leadership, excellence of character, integrity and community involvement.

Paddison Family Foundation Scholarships are four-year scholarships of \$10,000, payable at \$2,500 per year (subject to satisfactory performance and progress), for students of good character who have financial need and who have demonstrated academic achievement (3.0 GPA) and leadership ability. Requires FAFSA.

The **Pepsi Cola Scholarship** is a one-time award of \$1,000 to a student with scholastic achievement (at least 3.0 GPA) and a desire to pursue higher education.

The **Judson R. Porter Scholarship** is a one-time award of \$1000 to a student who demonstrates leadership and strong character, expresses interest in education or another helping profession, with a GPA of 3.0 or better and is recommended by the principal of either Asheville High or School of Inquiry and Life Science at Asheville (SILSA). Requires FAFSA.

The **Seth David Shillcock Olson Scholarship** is a one-time award of \$500 to a student who must have a GPA of 3.0 or better; have participated in AHS athletics; be able to document a history of employment experience and volunteer service to the community; be able to document financial need; be attending a publicly funded 4 year university; and be well rounded. Requires FAFSA.

The **Deborah M. Sizemore Scholarship** is a one-time award of \$2,500 to a student who must show evidence of participation in school or community music programs; acceptance in a music program in a two- or four- year college; and financial need will be given preference. Requires FAFSA.

The **Col. Alfred I. Thomas ROTC Scholarship** is a \$500 award to a student who must have participated in the ROTC for a minimum of 2 years; be accepted and intend to enroll in a 4-year university or college; show evidence of community service; have at least a 3.0 GPA. This award cannot be awarded if the applicant is a recipient of a full scholarship or academy appointment.

The **Eleanor and Charles Wykle Scholarship** is a \$500 award to a student of good character who has a history of service and is a good student (at least 3.0 GPA). Need is not a factor.
